READINESS ASSESSMENTS FOR WORLD LANGUAGE CLASSES

Any student is welcome to begin a language in Level 1. If you wish to enroll in Level 2 or higher, you must take a readiness assessment during the **week of May 15-19**. The dates and requirements **vary slightly by language** so please read carefully! **If there is a need to change your schedule by enrolling in a different level, you will receive an e-mail with instructions by June 30.** If you receive no notification, you should assume that you are scheduled to take the correct level. **Register to take your Readiness Assessment asap at the link provided!**

Chinese

- All rising freshmen wishing to enroll in **Chinese 2 or Chinese 3** are required to come to TJ to take a writing assessment on **Tuesday, May 16 at 4:20**. Report to Room 73. The **only** students exempt from taking this exam are those who have passed the FCPS world language credit exam or have received official credits in Chinese 1 and 2. These students may enroll in Chinese 3.

- Rising freshmen with an **official German 1 credit** from middle school can enroll in **German 2** and **do not need to take an R.A.**

Japanese

- Rising freshmen with FCPS language credits can proceed to their respective language courses.
- Rising freshman with **no FCPS language credits** who wish to enroll in **Level 2 or 3** are required to take a readiness assessment on **Monday, May 15 at 4:20** or **Wednesday, May 17 at 4:20 P.M.**

Latin

- Rising freshmen wishing to **enroll in Latin 2** **do NOT need** to take a readiness assessment under normal circumstances. The beginning of Latin 2 will include a review of Latin 1 material.
- Rising freshmen wishing to enroll in **Latin 3** **MUST take a readiness assessment** on one of the following dates: **Wednesday, May 17th at 4:20** or **Thursday, May 18 at 4:20**. Report to Room #62.
